Juror Amy Smith

Amy L. A., Smith of A. L.A.S. Art is a freelance artist and Ct native. Amy created the Mending Arts Program for Mental Health Ct. The program has continued to evolve and develop in many diverse community arenas. Amy has curated exhibits since 2002. The most recent shows include Hartford Art space Gallery , Mattatuck Museum. and NCC College. Prior to this, Amy was a director at Artwell Gallery in Torrington Ct. , and owned the A.L. A. S. Art LLC Gallery in Canton Ct. Amy recently illustrated her second book titled *Moonlight Wonder*, created by Pat Clark Smith. Between 2014-2016 , Amy worked on the photography for Hearts and Minds Without Fear: Arts in Education Organization with authors Barbara Clark Ed. D. and James Joss French PhD. on the Aran Islands, Ireland. Amy works as the studio assistant in stained glass and block printing for Some Kind of Art Gallery in Goshen Ct. In 2008, she collaborated with Pallet Fine Art Gallery to present *Holiday with Dali*, a rare collection of Salvador Dali's work at the Robin Alexander Gallery in Kent Ct. Amy's expressive and symbolic work utilizes a variety of mixed media and are in numerous private and public collections. Amy is recognized as a trusted champion for artists and the arts community by Mental Health Ct . She participated in the creative Arts Show Committee for Western Ct Mental Health Network and in 2017 was awarded the WCMHN Jim Matthies Empowerment Award for her work that has inspired people in recovery to discover their true nature as artists.

Theme Reference

The exploration of the realms of dreams, fantasy, and the unconscious mind has had a long history in the world of art. Artists from the 19th century Romantics ,to the Surrealists, and Abstract Expressionists in the 20th century, all have plumbed the depths of this fertile subject. So follow in the footsteps ,of the artists ,of these diverse movements ,and give us your best example of this time honored subject. This theme also includes abstract works of art.

Eligibility:

- Only original work.
- **All artwork must be submitted wired and ready for hanging or otherwise ready for gallery installation.**
- Any medium except Giclee prints or reproductions.
- Works may not exceed 48 inches in either dimension.
- Sculpture not to exceed 100 lbs. in weight.
- Artwork is to have been recently created.
- Artwork previously exhibited at the Firehouse Art Gallery will not be considered.
