Examples of hospital programs and projects the Auxiliary supports are the Toy Closet, Project Grants, a scholarship program, and Looking Forward. Past commitments include a \$500,000 pledge to the mammography van and \$1,000,000 for the Musculoskeletal Center and OB/Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.
